Guidelines for Field Trips to Intuit

Thank you for your interest in Intuit. We look forward to your visit! To ensure an enjoyable trip for you and your students, Intuit suggests the following:

- If a field trip is over twenty students, Intuit requires that you provide one adult chaperone per ten students.
- When first entering Intuit, please have all students take off their backpacks and place them in the performance space by the left wall.
- Although students are probably aware of this, please remind them not to touch or lean against any of the art.
- If you are handing out an assignment, please let us know beforehand and we can provide clipboards and pencils. Students should use pencils for assignments in the gallery. No pens please.
- Please make sure that your group knows that there are staff offices in the space. They should be relatively quiet, so staff can work.

If the group is larger than thirty students, we prefer to start off in the performance space. Students can comfortably sit and hear an introduction to Intuit and outsider art.

Large groups can break up into two smaller groups, and rotate between our Main Gallery and our Study Gallery.

After a tour, we suggest showing a film from our collection, which acts as a further introduction. Films can be selected based on your classroom needs. We have films ranging from art car documentaries to profiles of self-taught artists. Please visit www.art.org/educational/visit.htm for film recommendations.
